

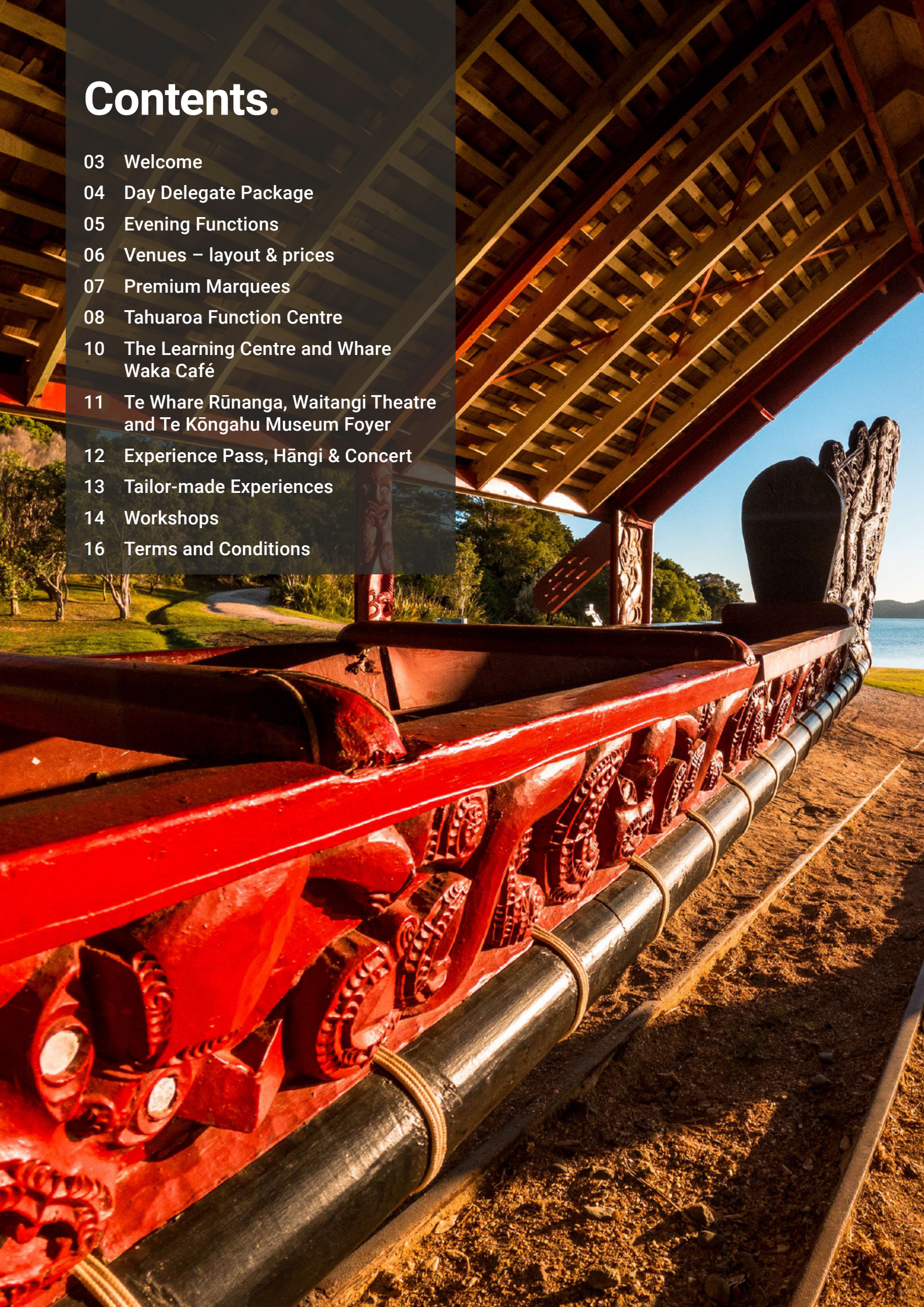

Premium Marquees.

With a variety of venues across the Estate we can tailor your experience and venue to suit your needs. From gala dinners and cocktail functions to film screenings and award nights, Waitangi is your bespoke destination.

Waitangi offers a premium state-of-the-art marquee with clear walls and roofing capturing the views and ambiance of the Treaty Grounds. The 15m x 30m premium marquee has black flooring and can seat 300 people. The marquee can be separated into two medium sized marquees, creating break-out spaces or extended to suit larger groups.

Waitangi also has stretch marquees that can be attached to our venues, and a range of smaller marquees that can be set up around the Grounds.



Tahuaroa Function Centre.

As a purpose built, customisable and modern event space, Tahuaroa will bring the wow factor to your next conference.

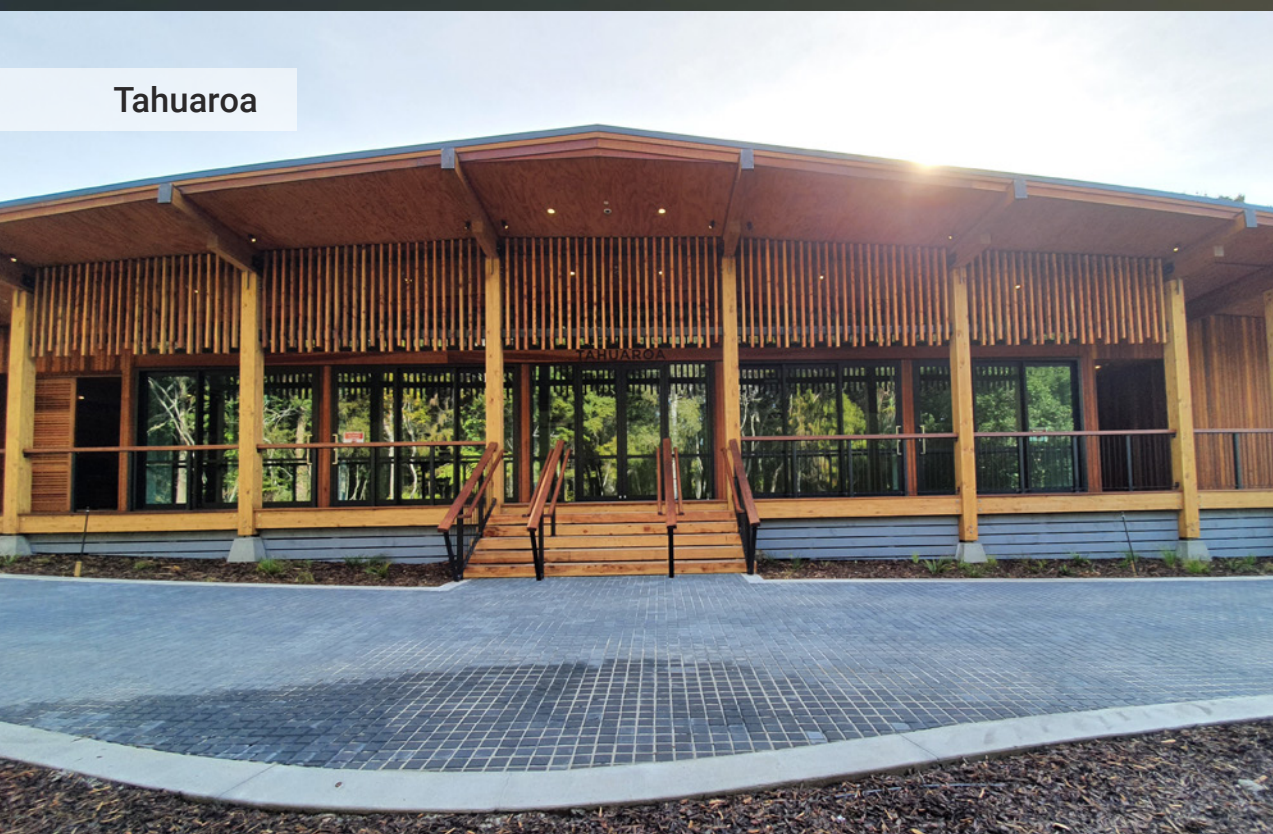
Tahuaroa, the recently opened event space with a venue capacity of 190, has transformed the portfolio of events Waitangi can cater for. Tahuaroa, meaning large open space, is part of Te Rau Aroha Museum of the Price of Citizenship, amongst the native trees of the upper Treaty Grounds. With its own private entrance, wraparound decking and contemporary design, Tahuaroa is a distinctive space for conferences, functions, meetings, weddings and events.

Fitted with a partitioning wall, Tahuaroa can be adapted into two separate rooms, Hokianga (140 m²) and Taumārere (60 m²). Each room comes with integrated technology controls, floor power points, speakers, projectors and air conditioning. The large stacking doors open out onto a private covered deck and courtyard area, perfect for outdoor entertainment and indoor-outdoor flow.

Learning Centre.

This modern conference room located inside Te Kōngahu offers a venue capacity of 100 with its own private entrance. The venue can also be accessed through the museum's exhibition gallery.

Whether you are looking for a medium sized venue or a breakout space, the Learning Centre is a great option. The room is equipped with built-in speakers, a projector and dual microphone system. Floor-to-ceiling glass windows look out on to native bush.

Te Whare Rūnanga.

Te Whare Rūnanga is a beautifully carved meeting house designed in traditional form. The meeting house reflects the stories and carving styles of iwi, or tribes, from across Aotearoa New Zealand and unites not only Māori and Pākehā, but all New Zealanders.

The whare comfortably seats 120 people inside on traditional wooden benches.

Private Hāngi & Concert.

Sample Māori cuisine and enjoy a captivating private performance.

The experience begins at Whare Waka Café, where you meet your host. The hāngi feast will be unveiled and the cooking process explained, while you are enjoying a drink.

Your host will ensure that you are fully briefed on Māori protocol and then escort you to Te Whare Rūnanga. There are three challenges from warriors before entering Te Whare Rūnanga for a high energy cultural performance. Enjoy a highlight tour on the way back to Whare Waka Café, where the hāngi dinner is served and matched with a selection of New Zealand wines and beers.

Tailor-made Experiences.

Q&A with the Curator

For larger groups we can organise a museum Q&A, where the group meet with the Curator of either Te Kōngahu Museum of Waitangi or Te Rau Aroha Museum of the Price of Citizenship for Q&A after the group has free time in the museum.

Duration: 20 minutes

Price: \$250

Pōwhiri (Traditional Māori welcome)

A traditional pōwhiri includes a wero (challenge), karanga (welcome call) and haka pōwhiri (group welcome chant). Speeches, waiata (songs) and hongī (pressing of noses) can also be incorporated. A Māori support person will brief visitors and accompany them throughout the pōwhiri. There will also be an opportunity for visitors to take photos and mix and mingle with the performers after the pōwhiri.

Duration: 20 minutes

Price: \$800 (up to 100 people). POA (over 100 people)

Private Cultural Performance

The performance starts with a spine-tingling wero (challenge) followed by a high-energy experience featuring waiata (songs), poi, stick games, Māori weaponry displays and the famous haka. Following the performance, visitors may take photos, ask questions, and interact with members of the resident performing arts group Te Pito Whenua.

Duration: 30 minutes

Price: \$1500 (up to 100 people). POA (over 100 people)

Pōwhiri and private cultural performances can also be offered off-site at a venue of your choice (additional charges apply)





Workshops.

Wood Carving Workshop

Meet and kōrero with our kaiwhakairo (carver) to learn the art of carving and create your own special piece to take home. MDF block, paint and chisels are provided.

Duration: 30 minutes

Waka Paddling Workshop – land-based

Immerse yourself in our land-based waka paddling workshop where you will learn some of the ancient techniques, actions and commands used in traditional and modern waka voyages, along with the history of these great seafaring vessels.

Kapa Haka Workshop

A high-energy workshop featuring waiata (songs), poi, stick games, Māori weaponry displays and the famous haka.

Traditional Māori Team Building Workshop

One-hour team building workshop featuring treasured Māori games crossing into themes of navigation, knowledge, learning history and stories, including 28 (Māori) Battalion. Presented by Harko Brown, Aotearoa/NZ World Indigenous Games Trust.

Introduction to Te Reo Māori

Find out more about Māori culture and language. This workshop includes basic Te Reo Māori words, an introduction to the structure and content of your pepeha (personal introduction). You will get a better understanding of tikanga (cultural protocols), learn a waiata (song) and understand more about how to pronounce Māori words and the use of macrons.

Terms and Conditions.

Please take time to read the following:

Venue Hire Rates

Venue hire rates are supplied upon application and are dependent on specific requirements of the chosen location and group size. Gear hire rates are fixed and supplied on request.

Booking Confirmation

To confirm a booking, please complete an application and send back to Waitangi Limited who will prepare an invoice for 25% deposit of your event quote. Booking will be deemed confirmed upon payment of this invoice.

Payment Terms

The remaining balance will be due 7 days prior to your event date, payable on invoice. Any additional costs will be invoiced following the function/event date or can be paid on the day with a credit card.

All invoices issued will be made payable to Waitangi Limited. Payment may be made by online via direct credit or credit card using your Booking ID as a reference. Please note that payment by credit card will incur 3% fee.

Cancellation Policy

Waitangi Limited reserves the right to require payment of the full cost when bookings are cancelled within 30 days of the confirmed date.

Where food and any other third-party costs have been incurred and cannot be used/returned, the 25% deposit plus these costs will be payable to Waitangi Limited.

COVID-19 Policy

Waitangi Treaty Grounds will be following the Government Guidelines in accordance with the current traffic light system. When date/s are confirmed Waitangi Treaty Grounds will ensure all Covid Level or Traffic Light regulations will be clearly communicated and adhered to.

If the COVID-19 Protection Framework traffic light system changes meaning the event cannot proceed as or as originally planned, clients have the right to postpone to another date within 12 months from the original booking. If the event is postponed to a date within six months of the original date, the original quoted price is applicable. If the event is moved to a date between 6-12 months from the original date, increased costs may apply. Deposits will be transferable to the postponement date.

Confirmation of Menus and Final Numbers

Confirmation is required no later than 7 days prior to the event; the final number of guests confirmed will constitute the minimum number charged for.

General Terms and Conditions

1. All protocols, rules, bylaws, policies (including Health & Safety procedures) of Waitangi Limited must be strictly adhered to and all lawful instruction and/or requests made by Waitangi management and staff must be complied with.
2. The rights and enjoyment of other visitors to the museum and grounds must be acknowledged and respected at all times.
3. Waitangi Treaty Grounds is smoke free; this must be adhered to by all attendees within the Grounds. If a smoking area is required, security to enable smoking access outside of the Grounds will be required at an additional cost.
4. The provision of Waitangi Limited equipment/ personnel/resources will be identified and mutually agreed upon. There may be costs payable to the Waitangi Limited depending on the nature of the requirements.
5. Where there are any additional security requirements identified by either party, there may be costs payable to the Waitangi Limited. Details of additional security and costs will be covered as applicable under a separate schedule.
6. The building/area/gear hired shall be left in the original condition at the conclusion of the event and any costs incurred by the Waitangi Limited to restore equipment or facilities to the original condition will be charged to the applicant.
7. Prices displayed in this brochure should act as a guide. Prices are subject to change from season to season. Please enquire for the prices of your specific event date.
