Lake Taupo is centrally located in the middle of the North Island, approximately 3 1/2 hours drive from Auckland and 4 1/2 hours drive from Wellington.

The beautiful Lake Taupo is about the size of Singapore—more of an inland sea really. It was created nearly two thousand years ago by a volcanic eruption.
